- **Product SKU:** Unique identifier for your product, apply the same naming convention or number for all associated variants, if applicable.
- Name: Display name for your Product or Product Title.
- Product URL Path: Create a unique, descriptive path for your storefront URL, like using the product SKU or a creative term. It should be lowercase, hyphenated, and free of spaces. (HTML formatting is not supported)
- Product Category: Use the format "Category > Sub-category" and ensure that the naming convention aligns with the <u>product taxonomy</u> provided.
- **Type:** Use the format "Type" and ensure that the naming convention aligns with the <u>product taxonomy</u> provided.

- Is Handmade: Is this a hand-crafted product? Yes/No
- Is Digital: Is this a product that is digitally delivered (not physical or shipped)? Yes/No
- Has Free Shipping: Does this product have free shipping? Yes/No
- Shipping Rate First: The shipping rate to use for the first item purchased on an order. Does not need to be filled out if product offers free shipping.
- Shipping Rate Additional: The shipping rate to use for each additional item purchased on an order. Does not need to be filled out if product offers free shipping.

- Primary Variant: Name of the first product option or variant, as specified in the product taxonomy (e.g., Generic US).
- Secondary Variant: Name of the second product option or variant, as specified in the product taxonomy (e.g., Primary Color).
- **Variant SKU:** Unique SKU for the specific variant.
- **Primary Variant Value:** Value for the first product option or variant, according to the product taxonomy (e.g., Small).
- **Primary Variant Custom Label:** Custom label to describe the primary variant value, if supported by the taxonomy.
- Secondary Variant Value: Value for the second product option or variant, according to the product taxonomy (e.g., Blue).
- Secondary Variant Custom Label: Custom label to describe the secondary variant value, if supported by the taxonomy (e.g., Light Blue).

- Description: The description of the product or variant. The product and variant description would both be used when a variant is selected.
 (Max 4000 characters).
- **Price:** Regular retail price for this product or variant before any discounts or sales.
- **Stock:** Number of units in stock for this specific variant.
- Weight (in ounces): The weight of the product or variant in ounces.
- Status: Product status (Published = available for sale, Draft = still being worked on, Archived = hidden but available).

- Main Image Url: The URL for the main image of the product or variant.
- Additional Image Url: Use these 10 columns to provide additional images for the product or variant. We maintain the order of the images and will overwrite any existing images used in that slot.
- Note:
- The columns are organized according to use, but they can be reordered as preferred.
- When updating, the only columns needed are the Product SKU (and Variant SKU if updating variants) and any other columns you want to include. When updating an existing product or variant, any empty fields will be ignored and will not remove any data.
- Fields noted for "Product" should only be used when defining a Product. Conversely, "Variant" fields should only be used for variants. "Either" fields can be used for either products or variants.
 If a Variant SKU is provided on a row, that row will be treated as a variant.
- Items that are noted as Required are only needed when adding new products or variants.
